This month, we are learning Surah An-Naas. It is surah NUMBER 114 in the Qur'an. It is 6 AYATS long.

Even if you already know it, this will be a great revision, and reminder of the meaning! Over the next few pages, you will see a section for each ayat. We are going to do this nice and easy. Cut out the section for the first ayat and have it on your desk, your bedside table, or wherever you will see it lots of times in the day! Pick it up and say the ayat out loud and read the meaning many times in the day. You can carry it around the house, in your pocket, or your bag. Just don't take it into the bathroom! Do it for as many days as you want, until you know the ayat by heart. Then, cut off the section for ayat number 2 and do the same, but this time say number 1 first. Then move onto number 3, and so on, until you know the whole surah insha'Allah!
